



Dear Family/Friends/Patients,

Our goal remains focused on providing you with outstanding urologic and surgical care in a safe environment. We implemented 100% of mask wearing in our facilities early this year based on CDC recommendations with some minor flexibility per ADA guidelines. Therefore, if you come to Idaho Urologic Institute or Surgery Center of Idaho, please bring and plan to wear a mask for the duration of your visit. In addition, we understand there are differing opinions on the value of wearing masks but during your time in our facility, we do “require” the wearing of masks.

We continue to monitor CDC, Central District Health, and other sources. And we will continue with recommended precautions. For instance, non-patients and non-essential services are still NOT permitted in facilities (Nampa & Boise clinics and the Meridian location). In addition, everyone entering the facility will be screened via questions and temperatures will be taken.

In SCI, one (1) visitor is permitted to join the patient “after” the surgery so the visitor and patient can hear the after-surgery instructions.

We do ask that if you have any respiratory symptoms (cough) and/or fever (or if you have in the last 72 hours), that you consider calling to reschedule your appointment.

In addition, we will continue offering telehealth (telemedicine, electronic, virtual, online visits) appointments for appropriate medical issues for patients with insurance coverage that recognizes telehealth.

We realize there is some inconvenience with these precautions, and we thank you in advance for your understanding and patience.
